Get ready for an inspiring evening featuring the music of renowned musician Steve Bell, mixed with powerful presentations by Canada's leading

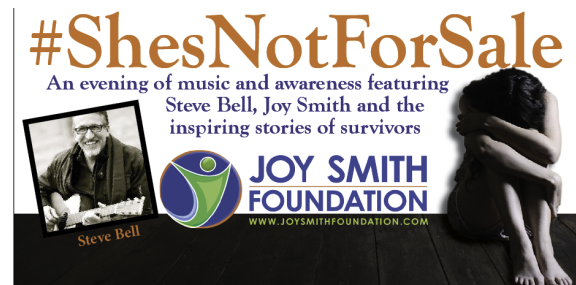

Ride for Refuge, tentatively set for Oct. 1, is a family-friendly cycling fundraiser that supports the vulnerable and exploited. The event raises awareness for organizations like the Joy Smith Foundation working to stop human trafficking in Canada by raising support for these victims.

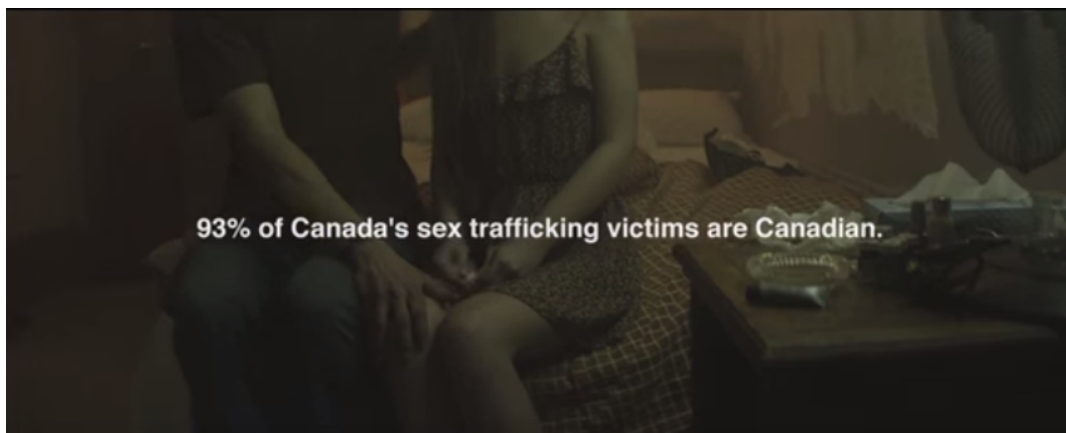
Riders from across Canada can choose covering various distances (up to 50 km).

Recent Initiatives



The Joy Smith Foundation was involved in launching The Grey Cup Initiative: Buying Sex is not a Sport campaign (#BuyingSexIsNotaSport). This campaign is a prevention and awareness initiative to show people that not only does human trafficking happen here in Canada, but that there is a rise in activity in human trafficking at major sports events. For example, a sting operation at the Super Bowl earlier this month led to 30 arrests.



The Joy Smith Foundation also recently completed a launch in Winnipeg for our Public Service Announcement (PSA) to combat human trafficking (#ShesNotForSale). We had many supporters come out, including the Winnipeg Police, pictured below. We also had coverage on the event by various news stations, including CBC.
